


## Sr Mary Martha Sarahes

10 May 2022 marks 160 years since the death of Sr Mary Martha Sarahes.



Martha succumbed to tuberculosis in 1862 at the age of 21. She was the first of the Sisters to die, and her early death was a great loss to the community. Despite their sadness, the Sisters were convinced of Martha's heavenly intercession for them and for their mission. She remains an abiding example of the "kind Samaritan".

She was born on an island in the Pacific and was

always cheerful and full of loving kindness.
